## Minimum Graduation Requirements

1. 120 credit hours
2. 45 upper-division credit hours (3000-4999 level)
3. 2.0 CU cumulative GPA
4. Residency: Last 30 credit hours of degree must be completed while registered in the College of Letters, Arts, and Sciences at UCCS

The BI Digital Media curriculum strategically intertwines both artistic and commercial contexts by integrating courses from Communication, English, Music, Technical Communication and Information Design (TCID) and Visual Arts.
